Ripe gooseberry and citrus aromas with herbaceous notes, showing some tropical fruit and lime on the palate. I

Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France £20.25
France
From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice. C

Marqués de Morano Rioja Reserva Spain £22.45
Matured raspberry and cherry fruit with hints of vanilla spice on the lingering, velvety finish. C

1. Altoritas Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile £13.75
175ml £3.70 250ml £4.90
Bright, refreshing, herbaceous aromas with gentle gooseberry and lemon fruit. 2

2. Cave de Massé Colombard-Ugni Blanc Medium Dry White, Vin de France £13.75
175ml £3.70 250ml £4.90
Clean, fruity, medium-dry palate, lemony aromas and apple freshness. 4

3. Table Peak Chenin Blanc Western Cape, South Africa £15.95
South Africa's most popular grape variety. Youthful, fruity character and a fresh zesty acidity. Very well balanced. 3

4. Kells Edge Chardonnay SE Australia £15.75
A medium-bodied dry wine with ripe fruit flavours and a fresh citrusy finish made from 100% unoaked chardonnay. 2

5. The Soul Tree, Sauvignon Blanc, India £19.95
Crisp, pleasant spices with good texture and nice finish. 2

6. Don Jacobo Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Corral, Spain £19.45
Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Viura grape. 2

7. Pinot Grigio Del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini, Italy £18.75
Lovely buttery, crisp and dry style with typical pear fruit from this area of central northern Italy in the southern section of Lombardy. 2

8. Chablis, Paul Deloux, France £23.95
Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis. I

11. Cave de Massé Merlot-Carignan Red, Vin de France £13.75
175ml £3.70 250ml £4.90
Deliciously soft, ripe, red fruit flavours with a smooth finish. A

12. Sun Tree Shiraz, SE Australia £15.95
Deep-coloured and full-bodied with lots of rich berry fruit on the palate and a pinch of pepper spice so typical of Shiraz. C

13. Santero Malbec Mendoza, Argentina £16.50
Plenty of ripe, soft berry fruit flavours with the usual hint of spice associated with Malbec as well as cinnamon and vanilla notes from a touch of oak ageing. B

14. Table Peak Pinotage Western Cape, South Africa £15.95
South Africa's own grape, a crossing of pinot noir & cinsault. Lovely fruit, smoky character and soft rounded tannins. C

15. The Soul Tree, Cabernet Sauvignon, India £19.95
Intense, spicy with pleasant fruit flavours and a smooth finish. C

16. Berri Estates Merlot, SE Australia £17.95
Several specially selected vineyards provide a delicious combination of raspberries, blueberries and soft plum characters. C

17. Marques de Morano Rioja Joven, Spain £18.75
A lighter style for Rioja, just a hint of traditional oakiness and abundant juicy ripe berries. C

18. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Collezione Marchesini, Italy £18.95
T From the Adriatic coastal region, shows a heady bouquet of violet and blackberries. B
